



Newborn/Infant Abductions

The following list includes all USA cases *documented* by NCMEC, IAHSS and FBI-NCAVC concerning the **Abductions by Non-Family Members from healthcare facilities, homes, and "other places" of Newborns/Infants (birth to 6 months)**. *Definition*: Non-Family members = not parents nor legal guardians. *Comparison data*: approximately 4.3 million births in USA yearly at more than 3,500 birthing facilities.

- 2009 = 11 abductions (all recovered unharmed).
(3 from Healthcare facilities : recovered unharmed)
- 2010 = 4 abductions (all recovered unharmed).
(1 from Healthcare facilities : recovered unharmed)
